


Twentieth century musical expression became a highly personal vernacular, Julia Perry wrote music that echoes Stravinsky, even as a Kentucky native. The Hungarian born Bartók uses folk melodies as his basis, and the sound of Prokofiev seems both radical and completely natural. Prepare for a musical journey into three great musical minds.




